AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in FIR No. 95, dated 14.12.2020, under Section 15C/61 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Bholath, District Kapurthala.

The only ground pressed for bail is the medical condition of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after rejection of the prayer by the Sessions Court, the medical condition has been deteriorated. He wants to place on record the latest medical reports of the petitioner.

Considering that there is a change in circumstances, the present

petition is disposed of with liberty to petitioner to approach the Sessions Court to establish the deteriorating medical condition of the petitioner. The Sessions Court will decide the petition for regular bail on merits without being influenced by the observations made in the order passed on 02.08.2021 rejecting the bail petition.

The petition is disposed of.
