Complaining wilful disobedience of the directions issued on 03.12.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the judgment reads as under :-

“This petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of a direction to the respondent-authorities to consider and take a decision on his legal notice dated 21.10.2021 (Annexure P-3) served upon the respondents.

Learned Assistant Advocate General appearing on behalf of the respondent-State of Punjab submits that the aforesaid legal notice dated 21.10.2021 of the petitioner shall be considered and a decision thereon shall be taken in accordance with law taking all the aspects into consideration.

In view of the statement made by learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, the petition stands disposed of.”
