The petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.64 dated 25.02.2020 under Sections 21 & 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

After arguing the matter at some length, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition and prays that a direction may be issued to the trial Court that in the event of the petitioner surrendering before the trial Court and moving an application seeking regular bail, such bail application so furnished by the petitioner, may be decided expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

In the event of the petition for regular bail being filed by the petitioner upon his surrender before the trial Court, such bail petition shall be decided expeditiously within a period of five working days.
