The petitioner has assailed the judgment dated 06.10.2017 passed by the Court of learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Patiala and the order dated 03.06.2017 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Patiala vide which charge under Section 406, 498-A IPC has been framed in the case bearing FIR No. 113 dated 27.10.2016 under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala.

Learned State counsel, on instructions of HC Sanjeev Kumar, has stated that the FIR against the petitioner has been quashed in terms of the order dated September 12, 2019 passed by this Court in CRM-M-28909-2019 and as such, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
