This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 153 dated 4.8.2020, under Sections 307, 379-B, 323, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Ferozepur.

After arguing for some time and realizing that his contentions are not finding favour, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within fifteen days from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

The petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner surrenders within fifteen days from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within two days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
