Through this petition, the petitioner seeks blanket anticipatory bail in any case registered in District Bathinda, at the behest of respondent No.3, in pursuance of the notice under Section 91 Cr.P.C. bearing No.371/5A dated 18.05.2022, and to give seven days advance notice to the petitioner in case of his arrest.

Compliance report dated 20.09.2022, by way of affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has also filed a vernacular copy of the letter dated 19.09.2022 written by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda, to the Additional Director General of Police (Internal Security) Punjab. The same is also taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that it is mentioned in the said letter that on the basis of the reports of Deputy District Attorney (Legal), Superintendent of Police (Investigation), and the Incharge, E.O. Wing, Bathinda, no cognizable offence is made out against the petitioner and

accordingly, no proceedings are being initiated by the prosecution agency against him.

In view of the above, the present petition has become infructuous.
