The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of an appropriate order or direction for quashing the impugned complaint dated 20.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) in complaint No. complaint No. 164 dated 21.09.2017 titled as "Jatinder Singh Vs. Simranjit Singh and others" under Sections 307, 323, 324, 341, 394, 395, 294, 295, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 57 of the Arms Act and Section 3 and 4 of the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 registered at Police Station Dugri, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana as well as summoning order dated 10.07.2018 (Annexure P-6).

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in the present petition, primarily legal issues were raised, but however, he seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take up all the points on merits as well as the legal arguments available to the petitioners.
