The present appeal has been preferred against order dated 24.06.2022 passed by the Vacation Judge-cum-Additional Sessions Judge, Kaithal, on an application filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking concession of pre-arrest bail in case FIR No.248 dated 01.06.2022 registered under Sections 323, 325 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3(1)(s) and 3(2)(va) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (which were added later on) at Police Station City Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Status report by way of an affidavit dated 16.09.2022 of Sh.Ravinder Sangwan, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kaithal has been filed by learned State counsel in the Court today which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel submits that in pursuance of order dated 15.07.2022 passed by this Court, the appellant has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present appeal is allowed and order dated 15.07.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the appellant is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
