HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the retiral benefits, for which the petitioner became entitled for upon his retirement, have not been released to him by the respondents, and therefore, the respondents be directed to release the said benefits forthwith in favour of the petitioner without any further delay.

Learned counsel for the parties concede the factum that during the pendency of the present petition, certain benefits have been released in favour of the petitioner by the respondents. A short affidavit dated 03.03.2020 has been filed in the Court today by learned counsel for the respondents, wherein the details of payments, which have been made to the petitioner by the respondents, have been given.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as the copy of said short affidavit dated 03.03.2020 has been supplied to her today itself,

therefore, she has not been able to contact the petitioner, so as to verify the genuineness of the payments and the correctness of calculations, as mentioned in the said affidavit. Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that the petitioner may kindly be given liberty to approach the respondents by filing a representation, in case the calculations, as mentioned in the short affidavit dated 03.03.2020, are not correct or petitioner is entitled for any amount over and above the said calculation and the respondents may kindly be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the petitioner raises any grievance by filing a representation before the respondents with regard to the calculation of the amount or any other entitlement, the said representation will be considered in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the submissions of learned counsel for the respondents, as recorded hereinbefore, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further at this stage.

Ordered accordingly.
