MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has approached this Court under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure to seek anticipatory bail in case FIR No.190 dated 15.10.2020 under Sections 5/13 (2) Haryana Gauvansh Sarankashan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 registered at Police Station Bicchore, District Nuh, who apprehends his arrest at the hands of Police.

On 15.09.2021, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned State counsel submits that as per her information, the status report has been filed in this petition.

However, the said status report is not available on the record.

Let the same be filed on or before 11.01.2022.

Meanwhile, in the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail on his furnishing requisite personal bond and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer.

However, the petitioner shall join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.

To be heard alongwith CRM-M-No.20469 of 2021 on 11.01.2022.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner has stated that in compliance of the above order, the petitioner associated himself in the investigation and cooperated during interrogation.

Learned State counsel who is instructed by ASI Naresh states that indeed the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 15.09.2021 is made absolute.
