The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in DDR No.45 dated 11.4.2022 filed under Sections 323, 451, 506, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added lateron), at Police Station Jamalpur in FIR No.74 dated 5.4.2022 registered under Sections 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC (Sections 354, 354-B IPC added lateron), at Police Station Jamalpur, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 14.07.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulbir Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and submitted that she is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 14.07.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
