Present petition has been filed with a prayer that appropriate direction be issued to the respondents to revise the pension of the petitioner w.e.f. 01.06.2011 keeping in view the actual basis salary being drawn by him instead of Rs.28,210/-.

After notice of motion, the respondents have filed the reply. In paragraph 3 of the short reply dated 08.09.2015, following have been mentioned:-

“3. Further, the department of the petitioner viz. Respondent No.3, sent the revised pension case of the petitioner on the basis of last pay of Rs.28,900/- after grant of ACP benefit under 4/9/14 scheme to the office of answering respondent vide their letter dated 11.12.2012. The office of answering respondent again, without any delay, authorized the revised pension @ Rs.14450/- per month with effect from 01.06.2011

and revised retirement gratuity for Rs.7,20,044/- in respect of the petitioner on 29.01.2013. Hence, the claim of the petitioner has already been settled in so far as the office of answering respondent is concerned. The payment of difference of retirement gratuity and leave encashment is to be made by the department of the petitioner and the payment of arrear of pension is to be made exclusively by the pension disbursing authority i.e. Bank/District Treasury Officer concerned. Since, the claim, of the petitioner has already been settled and no delay has ever occurred on the part of answering respondent, the petitioner is not entitled for interest from the office answering respondent.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, no further grievance of the petitioner survives in the present petition and the same may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
