Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the father of the petitioner namely Dalbir Singh died while in service hence, the legal heirs of Dalbir Singh became entitled for the grant of financial compassionate assistance as well as the compassionate appointment. Learned counsel submits that though at the time of the death of Dalbir Singh, the mother of the petitioner was alive but thereafter she has also died and the petitioner is the only claimant for the benefits in respect of the service rendered by Dalbir Singh. Learned counsel submits that petitioner is entitled for grant of benefit under Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006, which benefits are not being released to him and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the claim as being raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner with the respondents vide representation dated 05.05.2022 (Annexure P-9) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 05.05.2022 (Annexure P-9) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner on 05.05.2022 (Annexure P-9), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 05.05.2022 (Annexure P-9) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
