Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner is entitled for benefit of the service he had rendered from 1979 till 1985, which service has not been taken into account as a qualifying service while computing the pensionary benefits and also that the petitioner was not given promotion, when the said benefit was extended to his juniors. Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the petitioner is entitled for promotion to the higher post w.e.f the date person juniors to him was promoted.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Jagbir Malik, Additional AG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the petitioner has approached this Court straightway without raising the said grievance before the authorities concerned. Learned counsel further submits that in

case the petitioner has any grievance, he is free to raise the said grievance by filing appropriate representation and if any such grievance is raised before the authorities concerned, appropriate order on the prayer of the petitioner will be passed by the authorities concerned within a period of eight weeks of the receipt of any such representation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the above, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents so as to enable him to raise the grievance before the authorities concerned by way of representation.

Ordered accordingly.
