The petitioners, who are working as Lecturers in respondent No.1- College, are seeking regular pay scale and regularization of their services.

Learned counsel for the respondents state that the petitioners have filed this petition without availing the alternative remedy of approaching the Educational Tribunal. In terms of Section 7-A of the Punjab Privately Managed Recognized Schools Employees (Security of Service) Act, 1979, the Educational Tribunal shall have jurisdiction to hear all cases of dispute between the Managing Committees and the Employees.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of by relegating the petitioner to the Educational Tribunal, Punjab for redressal of his grievance. The petition stands transferred to the Educational Tribunal.

The parties shall appear before the Educational Tribunal on 20.04.2022.
