Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.190 dated 30.6.2021 registered under Sections 306/34 IPC at Police Station Kheripul, Faridabad.

By virtue of the order dated 16.11.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 16.11.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

However, learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner and submitted that there are serious allegations against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has duly complied with the interim order passed by this Court and she has already joined the

investigation and the State is in a position to conclude the investigation qua the

petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 16.11.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
