This is a petition that has been under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the selection of last selected candidate for the post of Male Constable (G.D.) in BCA Category, vide final result declared on 16.06.2022 (Annexure P-8), against Advertisement No.4/2020, Category No.1, dated 30.12.2020 (Annexure P-4). Prayer has also been made to appoint him for the said post being fully eligible than the last selected candidate.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if respondent No.2 is directed to consider and decide his representation dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P-10) seeking 10 marks under the socio economic criteria.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the representation of the petitioner.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation dated 06.07.2022 (Annexure P-10) and decide the same by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund. It is clarified that if the last selected candidate is likely to be affected by the speaking order, he shall be afforded an opportunity of hearing before passing of any such order.
