Prayer in this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent No. 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 8; with a further prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide protection to the petitioners.

Learned State counsel has referred to the reply dated 08.09.2021 as per which the petitioners have a land/property dispute with their own son Jagdeep Singh (respondent No.4) and respondents No.5 to 8, who are also the brother and close relatives of petitioner No.2 Gurdial Singh. FIR No.135 dated 26.09.2019 under Sections 306/34 IPC stands registered against petitioner No.2-Gurdial Singh and respondent No.4-

Jagdeep Singh and preventive proceedings under Section 107/151 Cr.P.C have also been initiated against petitioner No.2 Gurdial Singh and his son respondent No.4-Jagdeep Singh. In addition to this, FIR No.110/21 has also been registered on the statement of petitioner No.2- Gurdial Singh, wherein two accused have been arrested.

As per the reply, the petitioners are not facing any kind of threat or danger to their lives and property at the hands of private respondents and adequate protection is being provided by the local police in accordance with law.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with he liberty to the petitioners to approach the official respondents for protection in the future, if so required.
