AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and on instructions from ASI Sheesh Pal while refuting the aforesaid contention raised by the counsel for the petitioner, submits that the petitioner never came to the police station to join the investigation in the present case and rather he was arrested from some other place by the police in some another case registered against him under Section 307 IPC etc.

In view of above, this Court is of the view that the petitioner is not entitled to grant of discretionary relief of anticipatory bail in the present case.

Consequently, the present petition is dismissed.

Interim order of anticipatory bail stands vacated.
