Learned counsel for the petitioners argues that the petitioners worked in various Sports Nurseries, which are under the supervision of the District Sports Officer, Charkhi Dadri in various sports fields but, they have not been given honourarium/salary for the said period. Prayer of the petitioners is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the honourarium/salary for the said period to the petitioners along with the interest forthwith.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a legal notice dated 02.03.2022 (Annexure P/11), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.3 to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 02.03.2022 (Annexure P/11) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners in their legal notice, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 02.03.2022 (Annexure P/11) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
