On an application filed by the private respondent, his land has been transferred to another outlet. Appeal filed by the petitioner has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the outlet to which the land of the petitioner has been transferred is not in a position to support additional load. Thus, the authorities below were not justified in permitting the transfer.

A perusal of the record shows that no such objection was ever raised before the authorities below and thus, the same cannot be raised before this Court for the first time.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
