Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that though, keeping in view the reply dated 25.07.2022 filed by the Deputy Director (Technical) Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petitions, except that even though the petitioners are continuing in service but their salary has not been released to them by the respondents so far.

Learned State counsel submits that he has instructions to submit that in case any of the petitioners raises any grievance claiming release of the salary, the same will be considered by the respondents in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation raising the grievance and in case it is found that there is any merit in the claim raised by the petitioners, an appropriate order releasing the said relief, will be passed so as to redress the grievance of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the above, the present petitions be disposed off having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to avail any appropriate remedy available with them in case, the order passed by the respondents causes prejudice to them in any manner.

Ordered accordingly.
