1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 05.05.2022, in CWP-9333-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1, dated 05.05.2022, reveals that CWP-9333-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to pass a speaking order regarding the claim of the petitioner for reissuance of a passport within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order after taking into consideration all the relevant facts.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents states that claim of the petitioner was considered and passport of the petitioner has been revalidated w.e.f. 12.07.2022 to 11.07.2027 and the same would be dispatched to the petitioner by registered post/speed post/international mode of postage within three days from today, if already not done. Copy of passport showing revalidated details of the petitioner, as has been produced by counsel for the respondents, is taken on record. Copy thereof

circumstances, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

4. In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing the respondent to forward the revalidated passport to the petitioner by registered post/speed post/international mode of postage within three days from today, if already not done. Needless to mention in case the needful is not done, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition.
