Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.307 dated 15.03.2022, under Sections 406, 420, 498-A and 34 of IPC, at Police Station Hisar Sadar, District Hisar.

Status report filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.

Vide order dated 15.07.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.1-Rameshwar, who is father-in-law, of the complainant has died on 07.09.2022 and thus, the proceedings against him stands abated. Now this petition survives only *qua* petitioner No.2-Birmati and petitioner No.3-Parmod Kumar. He has further submitted that pursuant to order dated 15.07.2022, petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined the investigation and as such their interim bail may be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant has submitted that the parties have appeared before the Mediation Centre, however the same remained unsuccessful.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Om Parkash, affirmed the fact that the petitioners No.2 and 3 have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.

Complainant is present in person along with her counsel. On interaction with the complainant and counsel for both the parties, it is deciphered that there is no possibility of any further amicable settlement. The case needs to be thoroughly investigated and thereafter tried by the trial Court.

In view of the above, interim order dated 15.07.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
