This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.301 dated 15.11.2014 registered under Sections 411, 414, 489-A, 489-B, 489-C of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, Sections 15/18/21/22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Sections 3(34), 14 of the Foreigner Act) at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.
