Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.161 dated 30.07.2021, under Section 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged by the complainant, who is the wife of the petitioner that he had stolen the household articles. She also contends that the FIR is outcome of a matrimonial dispute and the matter had been referred to the mediation but it was not successful.

This Court, by the order dated 16.09.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gursharan Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 16.09.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
