1. Prayer in the petition is fortaking action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.08.2020, in CRM-M-24549-2020.
2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.08.2020, reveals that CRM-M-24549-2020, was disposed of by directing the respondent to take appropriate action on representation dated 04.08.2020, submitted by the petitioner, expeditiously.
3. Reply has already been filed. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of reply by way of affidavit filed by respondent No.1, the petitioner does not press the instant petition but liberty be granted to the petitioner to challenge Annexure R/6, rejecting the representation filed by the petitioner.
4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting the liberty as prayed for.
