Complaining wilful violation of the directions issued on 22.11.2021, the petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the judgment reads as under :-

“Be so as it may, the present petition is disposed off with the directions to the respondents to complete the election process preferably within a period of 90 days in terms of Section 28 of the Haryana Co-operative Act 1984 and Part II, Rule 3 and 4 of the Haryana Co-operative Societies Rules 1989.

Disposed off.”

Mr. Jaspal Singh Pannu, AAG, Haryana states that there were certain objections regarding preparation of the voter list which shall be sorted out within a period of two months.

After finalisation of voter list, the State shall proceed with the matter.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.
