This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.85 dated 20.10.2017, registered under Sections 458 and 323 IPC, at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

A perusal of the FIR would show that as per the same, even Amar Kaur, who is the mother of respondent No.2, is also a victim.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after entering into compromise with the mother of respondent No.2 as well and after making the said mother as party to the petition.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
