These two petitions were filed for cancellation of bail granted to
Jaivinder in case of FIR No.10 dated 16.2.2016 under Sections 406, 408,
420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.

One petition was filed by State of Punjab and another by the
complainant.

In connected writ petition i.e. CWP No.3357 of 2016, the matter
was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court. It was

ordered that these petitions be listed after the decision in the writ petition.

In view of the settlement arrived at, the writ petition was disposed of vide order dated 19.2.2020. From the order passed in the writ petition it is evident that the parties in the writ agreed to withdraw all the pending civil and criminal litigations.

In view of above, with the efflux of time and in absence of any contrary instructions with learned counsel for complainant and Jaivinder, the petitions are disposed of as infructuous.

However, the parties would be at liberty to seek revival of the petitions in case cause of action still survives.
