1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 01.10.2021, in CWP-37071-2019.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-37071-2019, was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned AAG, Haryana, has filed speaking order dated 27.09.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner for adjusting her on the post of Assistant Professor, Commerce (Extension Lecturer), in Government College, Alewa, Jind, or K.M. Government College, Narwana, Jind, against vacant post. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in view of rejection of the claim of the petitioner, vide

speaking order dated 27.09.2022, he does not press the instant petition but

prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 27.09.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to petitioner as prayed for.
