the petitioner may kindly be protected qua the same that while issuing medical certificate, the said aspect should also be taken care of.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that the Medical Board will be apprised about the apprehension of the petitioner and the said aspect will also be taken care of while making recommendation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
