Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.100 dated 26.05.2021 under Sections 387 & 506 IPC, registered at Police Station City Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and vide order of even date passed in CRM-M-54208-2021, praying for quashing of aforesaid FIR, on the basis of compromise, the parties are directed to appear before the trial Court for

recording their statements in support of the compromise. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last 11 months and is not involved in any other case.

Learned counsel for the complainant has acknowledged that there is a valid compromise between the parties.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate in the Court today and has not disputed the factum of compromise.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, without commenting anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
