[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 22.02.2022, in CRWP No.1571 of 2022.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) dated 22.02.2022, reveals that CRWP No.1571 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondents to take action on the complaints Annexure P/1 & Annexure P/2 filed by the petitioner within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order in accordance with law and provide protection to her, if so required.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that in view of Annexure R-1/T i.e. letter dated 12.04.2022, Annexure R-1/T i.e. report dated 13.07.2022 as well as the replies filed on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 4, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to challenge Annexure R-1/T

13.07.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
