The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for setting aside the impugned action of the respondents vide which juniors to the petitioner have been entered in list D-II and they have been promoted as Assistant Sub Inspector.

Learned State counsel would submit that the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner herein has been promoted as Assistant Sub Inspector w.e.f. 26.10.2021 vide order dated 18.08.2022.
