Complaining the wilful violation of the order dated 10.12.2021,
passed in Civil Writ Petition No.25108 of 2021 (Kashmir Singh vs. State of
Punjab and others), the petitioner has filed this petition under Section 12 of
the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971. The operative part of the order passed on
10.12.2021, reads as under:-

“In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but
without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ
petition is disposed off with direction to respondent no.2-
the Chief Engineer (HQ), PWD(B&R), Punjab, to
consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice in
accordance with law by passing speaking order within a
period of six months from the date of receipt of certified
copy of this order.”

Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Addl.A.G., Punjab, on instructions from Mr.
Gurpreet, the concerned official from the Department, has submitted that the
notice shall be considered and decided within a period of 4 weeks,
positively, from today.

In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.

Disposed of accordingly.
