Prayer in this writ petition is for a direction to the respondents to grant one notional increment for the period of one year to the petitioner to which he claims entitlement while relying on decision dated 16.03.2022 in CWP no. 32598 of 2019, titled Gurdev Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another.

It is submitted that the petitioner who was appointed on 28.08.1978 retired on 28.02.2017 as UDC/against Law Officer from the office of Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala. It is further submitted that petitioner is entitled to grant of one notional increment and revised pension after giving benefit thereof, but the same has not been granted to the petitioner. Representation dated 21.04.2022, Annexure P-1, in

this regard, it is stated was also served upon the respondents, but to no avail

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts the prayer for a decision on representation dated 21.04.2022 (Annexure P-1), in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Shiv Kumar Sharma, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Advance copy of the writ petition stands served. Learned counsel for the respondent does not raise any serious objection to the restricted prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the limited prayer addressed, facts and circumstances of the case but without expressing any opinion on the merits thereof, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide representation dated 21.04.2022, Annexure P-1 filed by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, within three (03) months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, petitioner is found entitled to any monetary benefit, same be released to him in accordance with law within the next two months.
