On 07.02.2022, the following order had been passed by this
court:-

“Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No.66, dated 20.05.2021, registered at Police Station Bhargo Camp, District Jalandhar, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 307, 341, 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the IPC, as also all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of a compromise (Annexure P-2), arrived at between the petitioners and respondent no.2.

On August 20, 2021 the following order haf been
passed by this Court:-

“Learned counsel requests for an
adjournment to argue on the issue of maintainability of
instant petition for quashing of FIR of amongst sections,

under Section 307 IPC. Adjourned to 28.09.2021.”

Thereafter, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought an adjournment on 03 dates in succession.

Today again a request for an adjournment has been made through video conference, on the ground that he is suffering from fever.

Adjourned to 22.02.2022.

It is made clear that if counsel for the petitioner or counsel nominated by him does not appear to argue the matter, it would be still taken up and decided as regards whether even the petition should be entertained or not, in view of the aforesaid order passed, and keeping in view the ratio of the judgements of the Supreme Court in Narinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others 2014 (2) R.C.R. (Criminal) 482 and State of Madhya Pradesh vs. Laxmi Narayan and others, 2019 (2) RCR (Crl.) 255.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner no longer wishes to pursue this petition.

Dismissed as having been withdrawn.
