In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that they are entitled for the minimum wages as fixed by the State Government, which benefit is not being extended to the petitioners and that too without any valid justification.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that not only the minimum wages is being denied to the petitioners but even the salary for the summer vacations and the gazetted holidays is also not being extended to the petitioners. Hence, the respondents are under obligation to grant the said benefit to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further argues that the claim as being raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioners with the respondents vide legal notice dated 16.04.2022 (Annexure P-11) and the petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondents to decide the said representation in a time

bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and Mr. Anil Chawla, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.6 and raise no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 16.04.2022 (Annexure P-11) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners on 16.04.2022 (Annexure P-11), respondent No.4 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 16.04.2022 (Annexure P-11) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
