The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.140 dated 26.05.2022 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 341, 379-B, 506 IPC and Section 325 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Saha, District Ambala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 18.07.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Bhupender Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 18.07.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 18.07.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
