Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case having FIR No.2 dated 2.1.2021 registered under Sections 22, 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station City Batala, District Batala.

State counsel apprised the Court that previously also, the petitioner approached this Court on which this Court passed the order (Annexure P-6) which reads as follows : -

“In view above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court within next 15 days and to file an application for grant of regular bail, which is to be decided by the trial Court in accordance with law after issuing its notice to the State, preferably within one week therefrom.”

In view of above, no ground is made out to grant discretionary relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner who failed to comply with the aforesaid order of this Court.

Dismissed.
