The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to ensure protection of life and property of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent Nos.4 to 8 and also for seeking directions that the petitioner should not be dispossessed from the land except in due course of law.

Learned Senior counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos.4 to 8 contends that the sale certificate with respect to the land pertaining to the decree passed by the Civil Court has already been executed and that the private respondent Nos.4 to 8 undertake not to dispossess the petitioner except in due course of law.

In view of above, no further cause of action survives in the present writ petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.
