This is second petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.48 dated 10.05.2021 registered under Sections 307, 302, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Section 302 of IPC has been added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1) as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

An earlier petition bearing No.CRM-M-11836-2022, on the same cause of action, was filed before this Hon'ble Court, in which, following order was passed on 05.04.2022 by this Court:-

“This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.48 dated 10.05.2021 registered under Sections 307, 302, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860

(Section 302 of IPC has been added later on) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Arniwala, District Fazilka (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to the petitioners to take up all the points as raised in the present petition and available to them, at the relevant stage before the trial Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners, in order to avoid imposition of heavy costs for having filed second petition on the same cause of action and that too seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise, in which, offences also include offence under Section 302 of IPC, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, stand disposed of in view of the abovesaid order.
