Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the respondents had issued an advertisement for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor (General Medicine) and the petitioner competed for the said post in the General category but could not make the grade. Learned counsel submits that all the posts of Assistant Professor in (General Medicine), advertised by the same advertisement in the category of EWS, could not be filled up and as per the advertisement, the unfilled posts were to be transferred to the General Category, which the respondents did not do hence, the petitioner has approached this Court claiming that the EWS category post which could not be filled up, be given to the petitioner by transferring the said in the General category.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further argues that the claim as being raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner with the respondents vide legal notice dated 18.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to respondents to decide the said representation in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 18.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner on 18.02.2022 (Annexure P-4), respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 18.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
