Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though in the writ petition, the claim which has been made by the petitioner is for promotion on the basis of rules governing his service whereas the petitioner, who is a specially abled person, is entitled for promotion under the Persons with Disability Act, 1995 keeping in view the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in **Civil Appeal No.59 of 2021** titled as **The State of Kerala and others versus Leesamma Joseph**, decided on 28.06.2021.

Learned State counsel submits that in case, the petitioners move any representation claiming the benefit of promotion under reservation in the handicapped category, the same will be considered in accordance with law keeping in view the number of posts existing in the said cadre and appropriate order will be passed within a period of 8 weeks from the receipt of any such representation and in case, after the decision of the said representation, the petitioner is found entitled for any benefit, the same shall also be extended to him within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the aforesaid statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner to approach the respondents claiming the promotion under the reserved category of physically handicapped.

Ordered accordingly.
