Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after the retirement, the petitioner has come to know that his pensionary benefits have not been released as per entitlement.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the similarly situated employees are getting higher benefits than the petitioner which is not justified.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of serving a representation dated 17.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) upon them, which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kiran Pal Singh, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 17.03.2022 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 1 is directed to decide the representation dated 17.03.2022 (Annexure P-1), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order. In case, after the decision of the claim of the petitioner, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for the monetary benefits, the same should also be paid to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
