This is a petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 12.01.2016 passed by the Authority, Minimum Wages Act, Circle-1, Sonapat, as per the provisions of Section 20 (2) of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948.

A perusal of the writ petition shows that the present petition has been filed qua a meager amount of Rs.6902/-, which was stated to be only the difference of due and actually paid salary of respondent No.1-workman for the period from January, 2015 to April, 2015.

In view of the fact that a small cause is involved in the matter, but without commenting upon merits of the case, this Court does not consider it appropriate to proceed further with the present petition, any more.

Dismissed.
