1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.05.2021 in CWP No.10273 of 2021 in case titled as Sarwan Singh vs Punjab State Power Corporation and others.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 dated 26.05.2021 reveals that CWP No.10273 of 2021 was disposed of with a direction to the Director (Administration), Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala (respondent herein) to treat the writ petition as representation on behalf of the petitioner and on submission of the writ petition to the respondent within fifteen days, the same be considered and action taken in respect thereto in accordance with law / relevant rules by the respondent within two months thereafter.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the notice issued, the respondent has accepted the claim of the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
