The present first petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.01 dated 13.01.2021, under Section 22(c) of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition, at this stage and prays that since the petitioner has been in custody since 13.01.2021 and only one witness has been examined, thus, a direction be given to the trial Court to expedite the trial.
