[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 22.04.2022 in CWP No.8262 of 2022 in case titled as M/s Ding Manpower and Securities Services Pvt. Ltd. vs. State of Haryana and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP No.8262 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the Director, Panchayat Department, Haryana to take note of pending representation dated 15.09.2021 filed by the petitioner and pass appropriate orders in respect thereto in accordance with law, preferably within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in case the petitioner was found entitled, to release payment to him forthwith but in case the petitioner was not found entitled, then the representation was required to be decided by passing a speaking order and communicating the same to the petitioner.

[3] Learned DAG has produced copy of order dated 03.08.2022

passed by the Director, Development and Panchayats Department, Haryana rejecting the representation filed by the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the petition with liberty to challenge order dated 03.08.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
